



DragonBird Theatre Photo and Video Policy

This policy covers the taking and subsequent use of images of DragonBird Theatre audiences by, or on behalf of, DragonBird Theatre. This includes images that may be used in our publications, websites and on social networking sites. DragonBird Theatre will follow these principles:

- We will not use audience names in photograph captions on our website or social media platforms
- We will obtain parental permission for a child to be photographed and videoed as part of a DragonBird Theatre event
- We will obtain the young person's consent prior to taking photographs or video at an event and inform them how the media will be used
- We will only use images of children in suitable clothing
- We will not approve, use or be responsible for photography or recordings made outside of events organised by DragonBird Theatre
- Audience members are not to engage in any photography or recording of other audience members without the other person's express permission

Parents, carers and family members supporting DragonBird Theatre events are requested to comply with the principles above. DragonBird Theatre cannot be responsible for any images or recordings made by our members or parents at our events or activities. However, any images or recordings made during DragonBird Theatre events that breach our own policy or which could be deemed unlawful, will be confiscated at the time of the event by the event organiser and appropriate action taken.

DragonBird Theatre audience members will always be consulted about the use of their photograph and told what the picture is going to be used for at the time the photographs or video is taken. Any images or video recordings of our members taken by, or on behalf of, DragonBird Theatre will be kept securely. DragonBird Theatre will ensure that all images used on our website and social media accounts comply with this policy and these outputs will be monitored regularly to ensure compliance.
